The mission of the OSCB is to provide performance experience for aspiring young dancers throughout their classical ballet training and making classical ballet accessible for the community to develop an appreciation for the performing arts; in particular, the youth. In our pursuit in nurturing talented young dancers, the ambition of Oakville Ballet is to provide much needed performing experience with fullscale productions to aspiring artists of age 10 and up. The repertoire of OSCB includes the full-length production of The Nutcracker (an Oakville family tradition for over 50 years), as well as selected pieces from ballets such as Sleeping Beauty, Swan Lake, Giselle, Les Sylphides, La Fille Mal Gardeé, La Bayadère, Paquita, as well as contemporary choreography Debbie Wilson's Eyes of Helios, and OSCB graduate Sarah Tarrant's Monochrome. Monochrome danced by OSCB graduates Lauren Harding and Connor Ladly-Fredeen, was performed at Youth America Grand Prix Finals in New York City. A number of graduates of OSCB have continued onto the professional world, joining Post- Secondary Programmes, or into the ranks of ballet companies world-wide. Most recently, Camille René-Waterhouse joined the English National Ballet School in London, England, and is now dancing professionally with a ballet company in Italy. Rachel Mortensen was offered a 3 year contract with the Bolshoi Ballet Academy in Moscow, Russia and returned to dance with the Bolshoi Ballet. Rachel is the first Canadian ever to graduate from the Bolshoi Ballet Academy! Congratulations Rachel!!! She is now a free-lance professional dancer here in Canada. Graduate Kurtis Grimaldi was honoured with the David Howard Emerging Artist Award in New York City, became a corps de ballet member of Alberta Ballet during their 2019/20 season and remains for his 5th season with Alberta Ballet. Alongside nurturing talented young dancers, we plan to continue to provide full scale productions alongside The Nutcracker, making classical ballet accessible to everyone, in particular, the youth. The OSCB wishes to extend their deepest appreciation to the artistic and creative teams for their brilliant contributions to our performances.

In 1892, Tchaikovsky composed the music for the full-length ballet "The Nutcracker". The ballet was presented in December of that same year at the Maryinsky Theatre in St. Petersburg, Russia.

The Grand Drawing Room

As the curtain rises, we find ourselves being taken to the Silberhaus home. It is the Christmas season at the home of the Silberhaus family. Clara and Fritz await the arrival of their friends and relatives for a party. Presents are exchanged and among the many gifts Clara receives is a Nutcracker from Herr Drosselmeyer, which, unbeknownst to the children, has certain magical powers. The children dance and play, and when the party is over, Clara and Fritz go to bed leaving the Nutcracker beneath the Christmas tree.

Clara's Dream

The grandfather clock strikes midnight as Drosselmeyer returns to the drawing room and the magic begins. Clara and Fritz are pulled to the drawing room by an army of mice where they find the Christmas tree is growing to an enormous size and the toys have come to life. A battle ensues between the Mouse King and his army, and General Nutcracker and his soldiers. Clara saves General Nutcracker, which leads to victory for the soldiers.

Clara and Fritz are introduced to the Snow Queen who graciously invites the children to travel through the Land of Snow to reach the Kingdom of Sweets. The Sugarplum Fairy welcomes Clara and Fritz. She is told how Clara saved General Nutcracker from the Mouse King and there follows a divertissement in her honour. A Spanish dance, a dance of the Mirlitons, a Chinese dance, a Russian dance, an Arabian dance; and then Mother Ginger appears with her Bonbons and Pulchinellas, accompanied by her pet poodle. The Sugarplum Fairy and Prince dance a Grand Pas de Deux and the Christmas flowers come to life and perform. The story comes to a close with Clara alone in the drawing room with her beloved Nutcracker.


